Making Friends: Playing and Learning Together

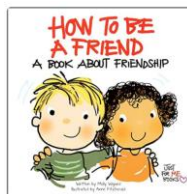
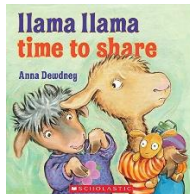
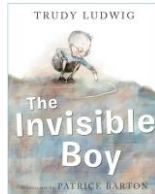

What I already know

Sticky Knowledge

Identify why rules are needed.
Suggest ways of making others feel safe and included.
Identify different ways that people become friends.
Recognise that friends can have similarities and differences.
Demonstrate some ways of being a good friend.
Identify some causes of arguments between friends.
Demonstrate strategies for positive play with friends.
Ask for help and know how to help someone else.
Recognise kind behaviour.
Describe how unkind behaviour can make people feel.
Recognise that feelings can affect how people behave.
Explain what to do and whom to tell, if they see or experience unkind behaviour.
Say why they should ask other people for permission.
Use simple phrases to ask for, give or not give permission.
